2.4 UNCONDITIONAL BASIC INCOME AT EU LEVEL

Introduction of an unconditional basic income at the European Level. This income would be individual (not familial), universal (all citizens and residents would receive it), unconditional (it would not be subject to any pre-conditions or level of wealth) and enough to cover the most fundamental basic needs financed through different reforms on taxes that would increase their progressivity.

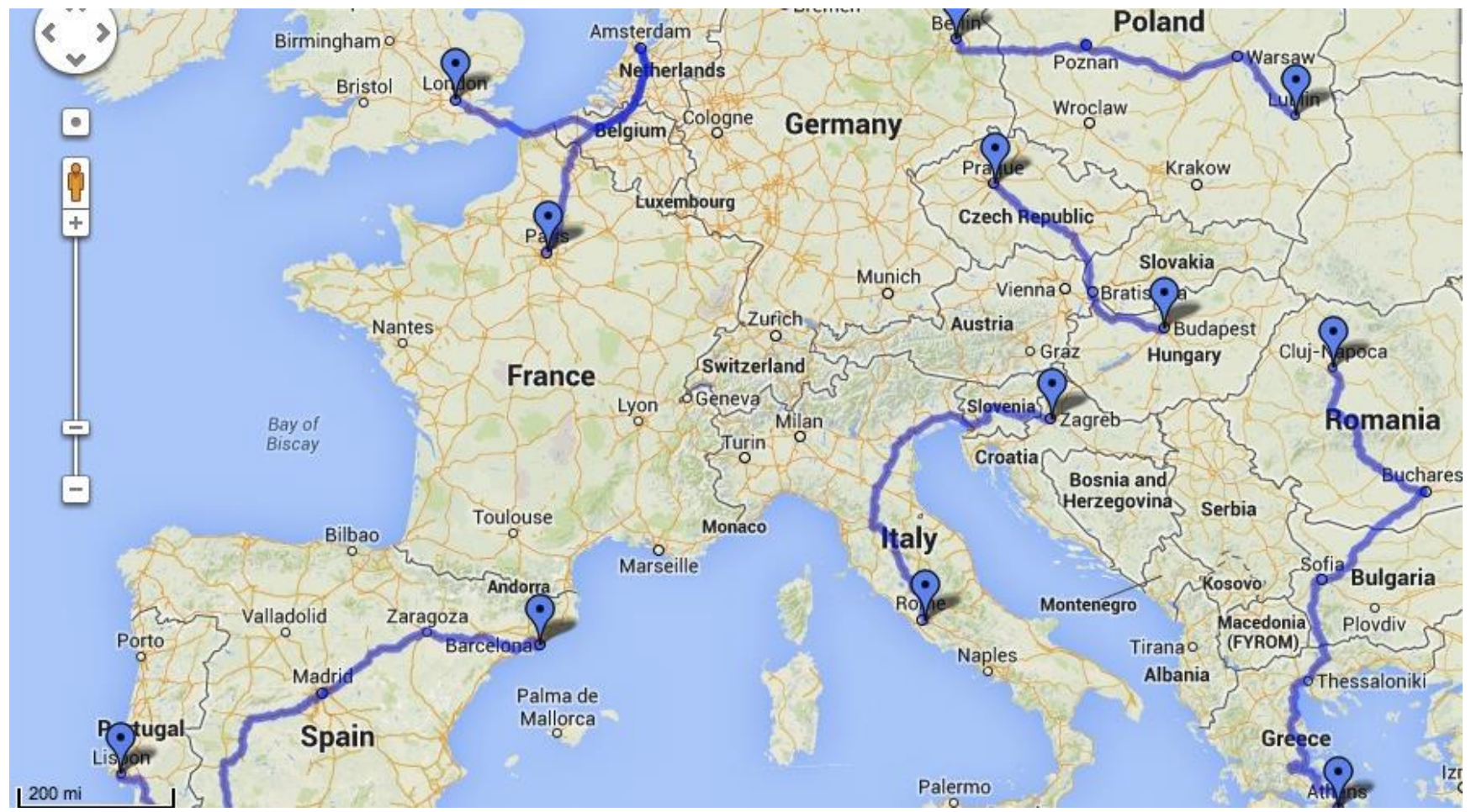
